WHAT WE DO.

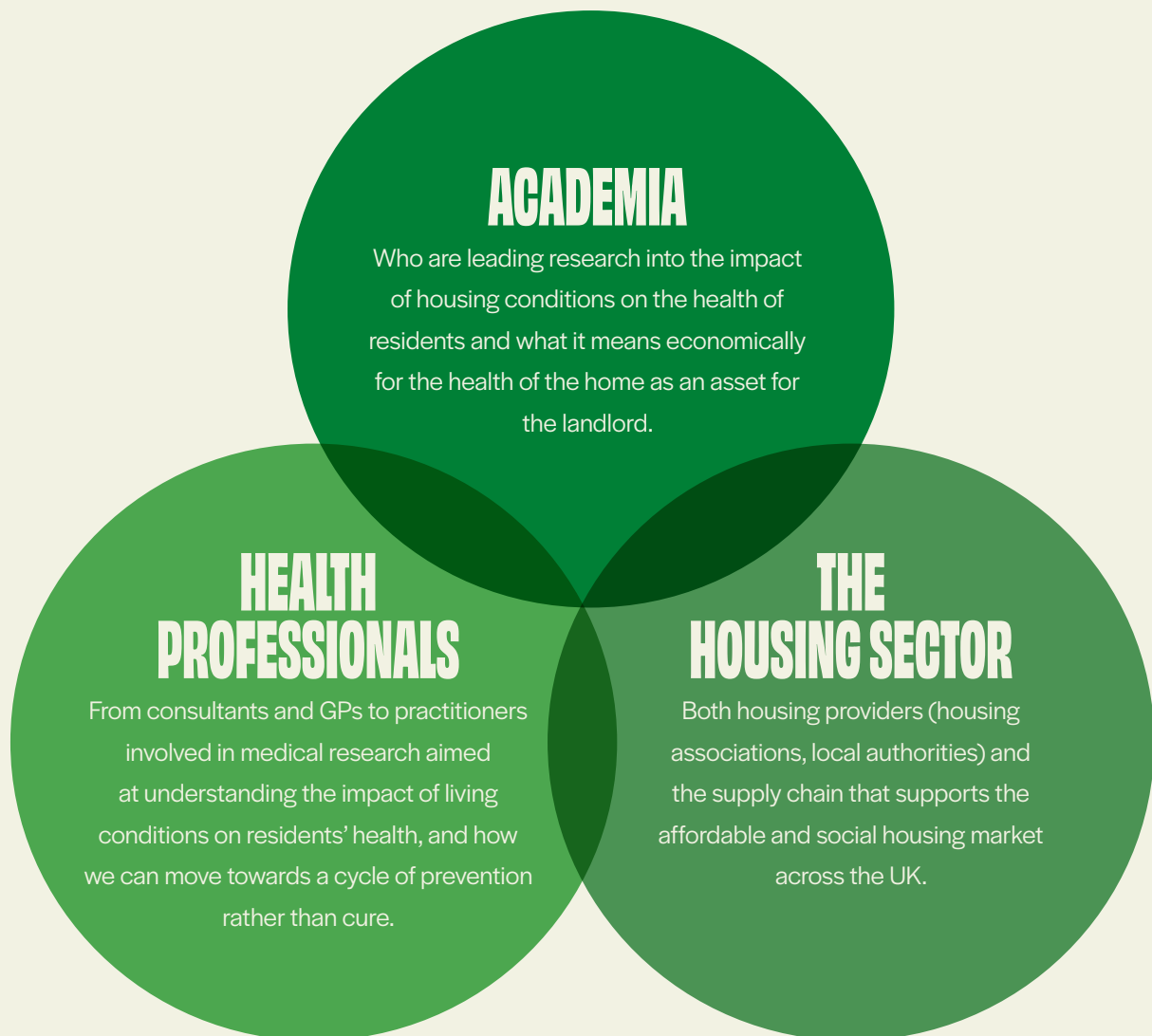

What binds this membership together is a shared commitment from informed and engaged people to improving the health of our affordable and social housing stock - for the benefit of residents and landlords alike.

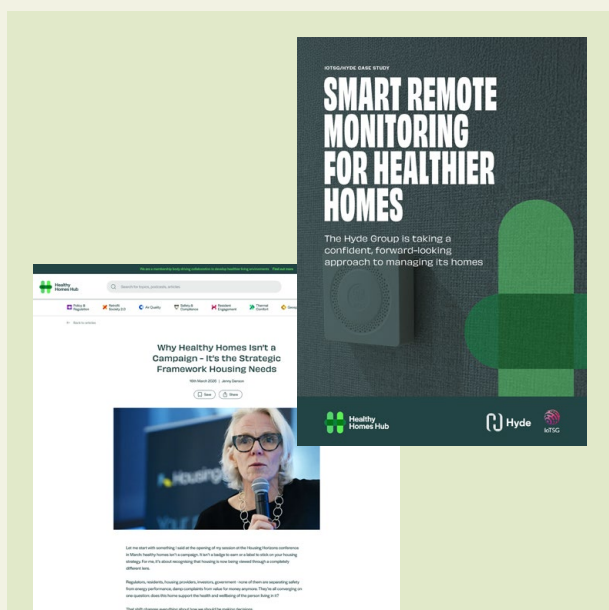


WHAT OUR MEMBERS GET.

EVENTS & NETWORKING.

Creating opportunities for collaboration, innovation and knowledge sharing is at the heart of our work, with members invited to participate in a variety of events throughout the year.



IDEAS EXCHANGE

Our flagship Ideas Exchange events are built to move the conversation on healthier homes forward - not just to talk about it, but to shape what happens next. Held twice a year, they bring together housing professionals, health, industry experts and academics to test ideas, challenge assumptions and share what's working in practice.

These popular sessions create space for honest, two-way dialogue. Not presentations for the sake of it, but conversations that reflect the realities organisations are dealing with day to day. For our members, this means access to practical insight, fresh perspectives and the opportunity to learn directly from others navigating the same challenges.

RETROFIT SOCIETY 2.0

Our quarterly Retrofit Society 2.0 sessions are designed to tackle one of the sector's biggest barriers - aligning retrofit delivery with the reality of finance.

These sessions bring together finance, treasury, sustainability and asset leaders to move the conversation forward - from theory and targets to what can actually be delivered at scale.

We work with key players from across energy and finance, with the Green Finance Institute and Energiesprong UK to create clearer insight into retrofit finance, stronger alignment between teams and partners, and greater confidence in how programmes are shaped and delivered.



PROJECTS.

We are increasingly focused on developing programmes that bring organisations together to explore particularly complex challenges that address health in housing in practice.

These initiatives are designed as collaborative space, where different perspectives, expertise and approaches can be brought together to test ideas, share learning and build a clearer understanding of what works. Our commercial members get the opportunity to participate in these projects increasing knowledge whilst contributing to wider sector learning.



WARM RENTS

The Warm Rents Programme is our flagship initiative focused on tackling one of the sector's most persistent challenges - cold homes. The programme is exploring a different approach - treating warmth as a core component of rent, not something residents must struggle to afford.

By working across multiple organisations and delivery models it is creating a shared space for learning, where approaches can be tested, compared and refined collectively.

The value for our participating commercial members lies in the strength of the collaboration and the foundations being put in place to generate meaningful, sector-relevant evidence.

Our aim is to eliminate fuel poverty from social housing.

OUR IMPACT

ASTHMA FRIENDLY HOMES

The Asthma Friendly Homes project in Tower Hamlets will produce a UK-wide blueprint for delivering Walsall Housing Group's Asthma-Friendly Homes model.

We'll be working with four housing providers (Clarion Housing Group, Gateway HA, Hyde Housing and The Riverside Group) with support from whg and Prima Housing Group, along with Barts Health NHS Trust and the local NHS ICB to create this blueprint via a suite of real-world tested playbooks for housing and health professionals and peer-to-peer Community Champions.

The project will enable our participating members to learn how to make homes more asthma friendly for children.



THE VALUE OF MEMBERSHIP.

The Healthy Homes Hub brings together housing providers and industry partners with a shared goal: improving outcomes for residents through better homes. This unites an informed and senior audience who are already actively engaged in the improvement of health outcomes from our affordable and social housing stock.

Healthy Homes Hub creates space for both housing providers and partners to shape how the sector approaches healthier homes.

BUILDING WHAT COMES NEXT.



Over the next 12 months we will be building on the foundations already in place - taking what has been tested and making it usable, practical and accessible across more organisations.

For commercial members, this means being part of the next phase as it happens. This includes access to emerging insight, involvement in evolving programmes, and the opportunity to apply new approaches as they are developed.

Our focus will be on embedding more preventative ways of working, supporting earlier identification of risk, and strengthening how data is used to inform both day-to-day and long-term strategic decisions.

Alongside this, we will continue to expand our programmes, partnerships and projects - creating more opportunities for commercial members to engage, contribute and benefit from shared learning that is directly relevant to the challenges they are facing.
